MY HOME & NEIGHBORHOOD

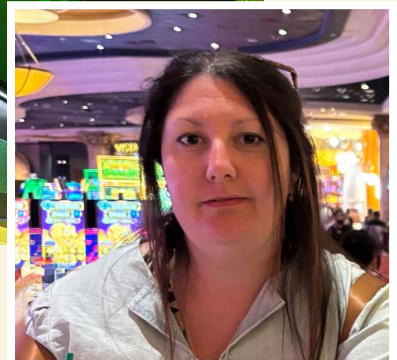
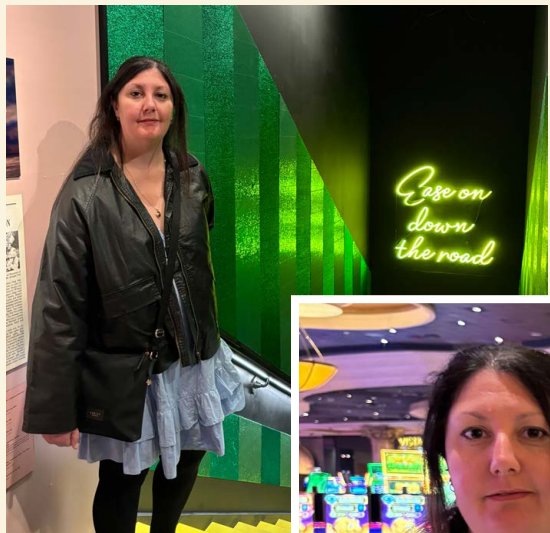

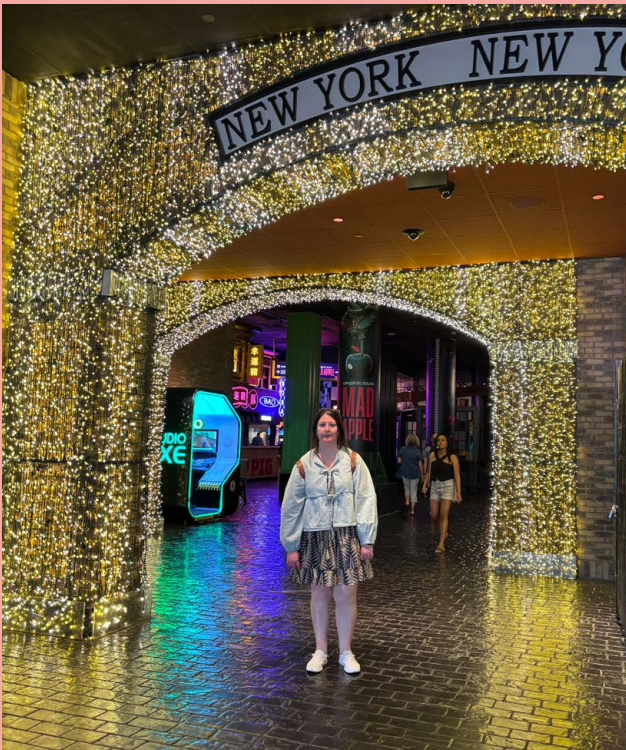


ADOPTION IN MY LIFE

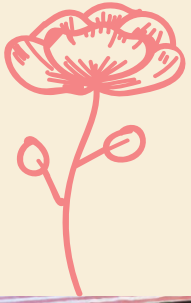
