OUR HOME & NEIGHBORHOOD

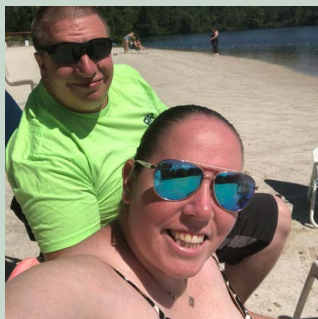
