♥ our love story

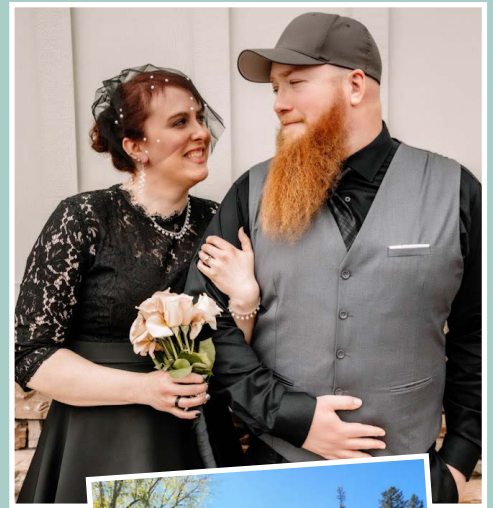
